TRANSPORT

Halberg is providing transport from Lakeland Park Camp to and from The Remarkables on Saturday, Sunday and Monday. A sign up sheet will be provided by Halberg at Lakeland Park each day. For those not staying at the Lakeland Park, transport requests can be made through the [WhatsApp group](#) and costs \$10 pp each way.

If you're planning to drive to The Remarkables you must carry chains and know how to fit them. This includes 4WD/ AWD vehicles.

Your mobility parking permit must be visible to use the accessible parking at the top of the mountain.

There is a drop off area at the top of the mountain road which you may use before heading to the lower parking or accessible parking area.

Parking attendants are available to assist you if you have any questions.

LIFT TICKETS

Please ensure you have a "MyPass" account before arriving at The Remarkables. This will speed up the ticketing process and get you on snow faster!

There will be a designated queue located at the far end of Guest Services (towards rentals) on the ground floor of the base building.
